The Jal Shakti Abhiyan was launched in 2019 in 1,592 blocks identified in 256 water stressed districts of the country. The *abhiyan* could not be taken up in 2020 in view of the restrictions imposed due to Covid-19 pandemic. However, a "Catch the Rain" campaign was taken up during this period. In 2021, the 'Jal Shakti Abhiyan: Catch the Rain, Where it falls, When it falls' was launched by Hon'ble Prime Minister on 22<sup>nd</sup> March, 2021 in all districts (rural as well as urban areas) in the country. JSA:CTR 2022 was launched by Hon'ble President on 29<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 with the same theme. JSA aims to promote water conservation with active participation of the people. It has now become a flagship initiative of the National Water Mission.

- 2. Ministry of Jal Shakti is now launching the **Jal Shakti Abhiyan-Catch the Rain-2023** with the theme **"Source Sustainability for Drinking Water"** from 4<sup>th</sup> March, 2023 to 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2023 in the entire country. As source development/ augmentation of existing water sources is necessary for ensuring potable and quality drinking water, JSA this year will focus on strengthening the water sources, particularly in 150 water stressed districts identified by the Department of Drinking Water & Sanitation (DoDW&S). The campaign will be launched on 4<sup>th</sup> March, 2023, with "Swachh Sujal Shakti Samman" event of DoDW&S, Ministry of Jal Shakti. This event is a prelude to the celebration of the International Women's Day on 8th March, and has been organized to felicitate women achievers who have contributed exceptionally in water and sanitation sector. Hon'ble President has kindly consented to grace the occasion.
- 3. The Cabinet Secretary will chair a meeting of the Committee of Secretaries (CoS) on 25<sup>th</sup> February, 2023 at 11:30 a.m. with the Secretaries of Ministries/Departments of Central Government and Chief Secretaries of the State Governments on JSA-CTR 2023.
