



The minutes of the meeting with the NGOs on NWM's "Catch the Rain" campaign held under the Chairmanship of Additional Secretary & Mission Director, National Water Mission, Department of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation on 11.06.2020 at 03:00 PM are forwarded herewith for information and necessary action.

Minutes of the meeting of NGOs held on 11.06.2020 for sensitization and participation in NWM's campaign on "Catch the Rain"

A meeting of the NGOs active in water sector was held under the chairmanship AS & MD, National Water Mission (NWM), DoWR, RD, and GR on 11.06.2020 at 03:00 PM through Webinar for their sensitization and participation in NWM's campaign on "Catch the Rain". During the meeting, 76 NGOs were invited which included 62 NGOs empaneled with NWM. The list of participants is annexed.

2. In his welcome address, Shri J.P. Singh, Deputy Secretary, NWM mentioned that NWM is seeking the participation of NGOs on "Catch the Rain" campaign launched by NWM. In the Inter Ministerial Committee(IMC) on Water Conservation's meeting held under the chairmanship of Secretary DoWR, RD, GR on 16th January 2020 wherein a plan on 'Catch the Rain' was presented by the NWM. He also referred to the last meeting on 9th March 2020 with the NGOs empaneled with NWM to seek their participation of NGOs in activities related to the five identified goals of NWM. He further noted that NWM'S campaign 'Catch the Rain' is to nudge states and stakeholders to create Rain Water Harvesting Structures (RWHS) suitable to the climatic conditions and soil conditions before the onset of ensuing monsoon. Under this campaign, NWM has already sensitized the state governments at the level of chief secretaries as well as at the cutting edge level of DMs to participate in the Catch The Rain campaign with participation of community. He informed that NWM conducted a workshop on 'Catch the Rain: Rain Water Harvesting and Artificial Recharge Structures for Water Conservation' theme at New Delhi on 13.03.2020. He further mentioned that with this meeting, NWM seeks active participation of the NGOs in the Catch The Rain campaign of the NWM for sensitization and for coordination between states and other water sector stakeholders to work together for water conservation. He then invited AS&MD, NWM to present his views.

3. Shri G. Asok Kumar, Additional Secretary & Mission Director, NWM made a presentation on the efforts of NWM in "Catch the Rain" campaign. He stated that this campaign is about "catch the rain, when it falls, where it falls". He explained various activities planned under "Catch the Rain" campaign which include drives to make check dams, water harvesting pits, Rooftop RWHS, etc., removal of encroachments, de-silting of tanks to increase their storage capacity, removal of obstructions in the

channels which bring water to them from the catchment areas, repairs to step-wells and using defunct bore-wells & unused wells to put water back to aquifers. He stressed that these activities should be taken with the active participation of community. He apprised that he has sent DO letters to Chief Secretaries of all States/UTs on 27.02.2020, requesting (i) to prepare a plan of action to develop Rain Water Harvesting Structures (RWHS) so that these are ready to "Catch The Rain", when the monsoon arrives; (ii) to ensure rooftop RWHS on all government, semi-government and corporate buildings before monsoon; and (iii) to establish Rain Water Centres (RWCs) in every district headquarters to generate awareness and give technical guidance on RWHS. Besides, a workshop was also organized on 'Catch the Rain: Rain Water Harvesting and Artificial Recharge Structures for Water Conservation' at New Delhi on 13.03.2020 to sensitize the stakeholders. He also mentioned that another DO letter was sent to all DMs/DCs on 11.05.2020 to take steps to ensure appropriate rainwater harvesting & artificial recharge measures in all catchment zones under their jurisdiction before the onset of the monsoon season. NWM has requested the states/ UTs to establish the raincenters to give technical guidance on RWHS as well as water conservation structures and toll free numbers and blogs/websites should be set up to help exchange ideas and best practices.

4. AS&MD, NWM also requested the NGOs to send their correspondence related to "Catch the Rain" and success stories on water conservation, RWH & AR structures to the NWM at newly created email Id catchtherain@gmail.com. He also apprised about the DO letter dated 24.04.2020 jointly written by 4 Secretaries of GoI to converge all programs & schemes including MGNREGA of water conservation. He mentioned that, in the present circumstances of the pandemic Covid19, MHA has allowed MGNREGS works to be undertaken on priority, particularly relating to irrigation and water conservation. He also informed that an additional Rs. 40,000 crore has been allotted in addition to the total budget allocation of Rs. 101,500 crore in MGNREGS. He stated that under "Atmnirbhar Bharat Abhiyan", 116 districts have been identified in which water conservation activities may be taken up on priority under MGNREGS and this Department is in the process of nominating technical officers for providing technical guidance on water conservation and RWHS .

5. Thereafter, NGOs were invited to make their comments. Clarifications were

given to issues raised by them. NGOs assured for their active support in carrying forward the Catch the Rain campaign of NWM.

6. After detailed deliberations, the following decisions were taken:

(i) A letter will be sent to DM/District Collectors of the area of operation of the NGOs introducing them as an accredited NGO with NWM.

(ii) In their areas of operation, NGO should act as facilitator & link between NWM & state departments.

(iii) All water bodies in districts will be enumerated (checked with revenue records) and encroachments will be removed.

(iv) NGOs will send a detail of the work done on water conservation in their areas of operation on the newly created email Id catchtherain@gmail.com and their weekly/daily updation should be done. NGOs will share the success stories related to the water sector.

(v) NGOs may facilitate the setting up of Rain Centre in the districts and if required, may undertake training & capacity building for this purpose.

(vi) NGOs will help in publicity & IEC of the NWM's campaign on "Catch the Rain". For this purpose, NWM will extend financial assistance to the tune of Rs. 10000/- to each NGO for undertaking IEC activities on catch the rain campaign of the NWM. These NGOs may be engaged in promoting awareness about NWM's catch the rain campaign by putting posters, flex, wall paintings, banners etc in their areas of operation.

10. The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
